Not illustrated. 1908 Excerpt: .white pine, hard rubber and celluloid, the latter being very easy to bend and consequently used where the curves are very abrupt or sharp, such as the after ends of water-lines. A hard rubber batten is a little stirrer than a celluloid one and on a cold day should be warmed a little before being used, as they are quite brittle. It is not possible to give the exact sizes required as they vary so, depending on the holly and cut out, the edges being finished off with a coarse file and, say, two grades of sandpaper glued to small pieces of wood, after which the flat sides of the curves may be sandpapered smooth and then filled with oil and rubbed down. This will protect the wood from absorbing ink and they will always remain bright. The necessary paper to do the drawing on can...
