

Among the nearly 140 footnoted quotes included here are Forrests thoughts on warfare, military rules, West Point graduates, education, friendship, and even drinking, gambling, cussing, and morality. From the Generals own words we learn that he was not an illiterate inbred hillbilly, a monstrous racist, or a cruel and violent slave owner, as the North and New South disingenuously continue to preach. Quite the opposite. He was not only, as Confederate General Richard Taylor said of him, a tender-hearted, kindly man, he was also a true Southern gentleman, a fair and compassionate Rebel officer, a successful businessman, and a faithful husband who loved children, protected women, and gave charitably to war veterans,...
